

Who can use this service?

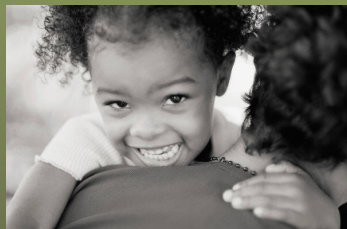
Organisations such as schools, voluntary services, independent fostering agencies, local authorities etc. are welcome to commission services from me.

What can I offer?

Highly tailored, specialist input for Looked After and Adopted Children. Using a multi modality approach I work with children who have suffered severe relational trauma in infancy and early childhood that now impairs their capacity to enjoy a family setting. This work can include elements of Therapy, EMDR, sensory attachment interventions, sandplay and other non-verbal and verbal methods as required. I also support the network around the child including working with schools and carers.

Additionally I can offer stand-alone consultation to professionals, parents and carers working with children. I can offer assessments of therapeutic need which can include Story Stem assessment.

I provide clinical supervision for general therapeutic input and for Therapy.

About me ...

I trained as a psychodynamic counsellor and obtained my BACP accreditation in 1996. I have worked in Child and Adolescent Mental Health (CAMHS), education establishments and in private practice. I provide direct work to children and families and also consultation to those who work with them. I am a teaching associate at the Faculty of Education, University of Cambridge

Through continuing professional development I keep my skills in line with current evidence based practice. I am an accredited story stem assessor, a Certified Therapy® Therapist and am training as a Therapy trainer and supervisor. I have undertaken the Level 1 and 2 EMDR training and initial training in sensory attachment intervention.
